



Radius Mouldings

Building plans may have **concave, convex or arch radius** details that will affect which mouldings are chosen for finishing.

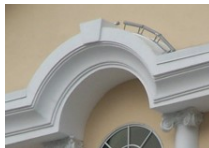
Concave

Arch

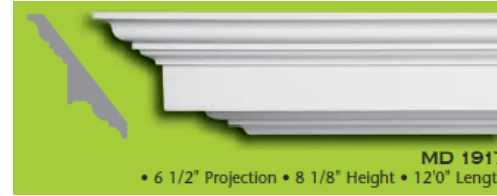


Arch radius is commonly referred to as an eyebrow radius.

Spectis Moulders has 3 ways we can provide radius mouldings to suit your requirement.

1. Pre-radiused rigid—generally made in 3' lengths at the exact radius needed
2. Ironflex—pliable material for interior or exterior use
3. Decoflex—pliable material for interior use only

Standard polyurethane mouldings that have a flat back and are less than 2" P can have a **concave/convex radius** capability of approximately R=4'-0". Polyurethane products are more flexible than the pine wood equivalent but there are integral properties that must still be respected. Profile, height and thickness are key points to keep in mind.



When a **concave/convex radius** is needed with a crown moulding like MD1917 for example, we will usually quote a custom rigid moulding in a 3'-0"

length. When the requirement crown moulding has a repeat we will keep the repeat lengths in mind for ease of installation.

With an **arch or eyebrow radius**, get in touch with our customer service team for a custom quote. Indicate the moulding number, radius and arc length needed.
